## Chuck Snyder

April 20, 1933 – December 12, 2013

Chuck Snyder was born April 20, 1933 in Seattle, Washington. He was raised in Tacoma, Washington but spent his summers on his Grandparent's wheat ranch in Coulee City where he started driving truck in the fields at age nine.

He attended Stadium High School in Tacoma and graduated from Washington State College, majoring in Communications. Chuck and Barb met at Washington State and were married in 1955. They spent two years in the Army in New Jersey and North Carolina. During those two years they were blessed with their son Tim and daughter Beverly Anne. Many years later, they adopted their child of love, Deb Amble when she was 34 years old. They have the World's Most Perfect Grandchildren, three girls and three boys.

Chuck worked for KING TV for eleven years and then owned his own agency called Chuck Snyder Advertising. He wrote all the commercials himself as well as being an on-the-air talent. His major clients were Frederick and Nelson, Safeway for five states, Sears, Phil Smart Mercedes and Blade Chevrolet.

Chuck and Barb were co-chaplains for the University of Washington Husky Football team for six years in the 1980's traveling to all their games as well as the Orange Bowl which the team won. They also taught the Seahawk Couple's Bible Study for 27 years. Chuck was Chaplain of the Seattle Mariner's Baseball team for 27 years while Barb taught the Mariner Wives Bible Study for 28 years. During that time they also taught a large class at Crossroads Bible Church in Bellevue, Washington. Adding to that, they traveled throughout Canada and the United States doing weekend Marriage Conferences. While they were busy doing everything else, they wrote a book together, "Incompatibility: Still Grounds for a Great Marriage". Chuck wrote several books, including "Men: Some Assembly Required" and "The Way to a Woman's Heart". While Barb has been teaching a Bible Study called Precept upon Precept...Chuck taught a business men's Bible Study for 27 years. They also taught and served on the staff of Pro Athletes Outreach conferences for professional athletes until 2006. Chuck also counseled world-wide via the internet.
